The Plymouth Robotics program provides 7th through 12th grade students at Lincoln Jr. High and Plymouth High School the opportunity to design, build, and compete with a robot. There are almost 40 students involved and we grow each year.

Our teams are designed so that every child has a major impact. Our sub-teams all take on different tasks and responsibilities. After competing at the State competition at Lucas Oil Stadium, two of our teams were given the Excellence Award, the highest honor given to the top overall team in each division. To be named Indiana's top two teams out of many others was a huge honor, but the excitement didn't end there. One of our teams qualified to attend the World Championships in Dallas, TX. Receiving the Excellence Award was an unforgettable experience for all Plymouth Robotics students, coaches, and parents, and a huge testament to the talent, hard work, and dedication from all involved.

As exciting as our successes have been, running a top-tier robotics program costs quite a bit of money. Fortunately for us, we are well equipped thanks to generous donations and grants in the past. But the need is always there. Included is a list of just some of the expenses we incur on a yearly basis:

Team Jerseys/Uniforms: \$50+ per team member

Team Registration: \$150 (x9 teams)

Robotics Kits: \$1899 a piece

Field/Elements: \$500

Regional Competition Entry Fees: \$80 (x9 teams x5 competitions)

State Entry Fee: \$200 (each qualifying team)

Worlds Entry Fee: \$1200 (each qualifying team)

Our goal at the beginning of every season is to qualify for State and Worlds. Though a small percentage of teams accomplish this, we like to set high expectations. We strongly believe the lessons learned and experiences gained through our robotics program will change the trajectory of students' lives for many years.
